To give the Association:

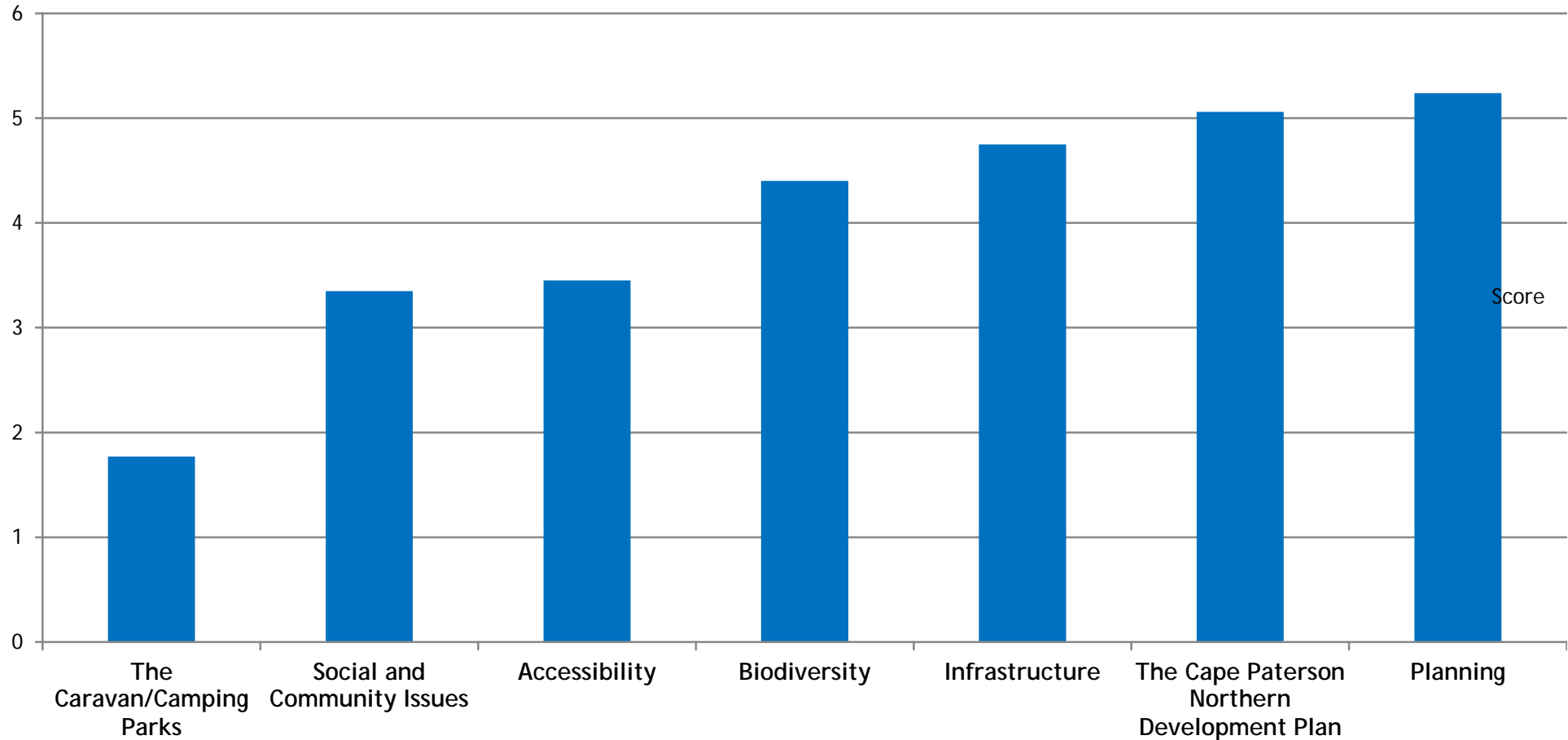
- ▶ More formal structure

Survey of membership conducted

- ▶ 128 responses
- ▶ 75 extra issues raised
- ▶ Then categorised
- ▶ Four goals selected
- ▶ Almost all issues covered

Vision

- ▶ To ensure Cape Paterson remains a coastal town with high quality liveability that conserves its natural environment



Mission

- ▶ To protect and enhance the current and future liveability and biodiversity of Cape Paterson



4 Goals resulting from the survey

1. *Maintain, enhance and protect the natural environment (i.e. biodiversity)*
2. *Preserve the character of Cape Paterson through appropriate planning*
3. *Advocate for infrastructure developments that enhance the liveability of Cape Paterson*
4. *Identify and advocate for the social, health and wellbeing needs of the community*



Implementing the goals

- ▶ The Annual Operational Plan



Operational Principles

- ▶ Cooperation and collaboration
- ▶ Portfolio holder for each goal
- ▶ Timelines for assessment of progress
