

Hints and tips

Using your Organics bin:

- Placing newspaper at the bottom of your Caddy will help absorb small amounts of liquid
- During hot weather, freeze meat and seafood scraps until just before collection day
- Empty your Caddy regularly
- Keep your Caddy liners in a cool dry place

To prevent nappy odour in your Landfill bin:

- Store your red Landfill bin in the shade
- Double bag your nappies
- Dispose of any solid waste in the toilet before putting nappies into your red Landfill bin
- Use odour removing products such as odour removal crystals or bin fresheners

Your weekly **Organics** service

These items can go in your **Organics** bin:



- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Meat scraps and bones
- Fish and seafood
- Dairy products
- Bread and bakery products
- Pasta and rice
- Tea and coffee grounds
- Tissues and paper towels
- Pet manure and compostable kitty litter
- Lawn clippings
- Garden prunings (including weeds)
- Twigs and branches under 100mm in diameter
- Hair (human and pet)

Your **Kitchen Caddy**

Your Kitchen Caddy will help you separate and sort food waste for your Organics bin



1. Line your Kitchen Caddy with the liners provided and place food scraps inside

Please don't use plastic bags in your Kitchen Caddy. Only use Council provided liners



2. When the liner is full, tie it up and remove it from the Caddy



3. Place liner into the green lid Organics Bin

What happens to my organic waste?

Your organic waste will be processed into certified organic compost at Dutson Downs Soil and Organic Recycling Facility. The Facility processes the organic waste into compost that is returned to farms and public gardens to improve soils.

Your fortnightly **Recycling** service



These items go in your yellow Recycling bin:

- Glass bottles and jars
- Solid plastic containers, bottles and tubs
- Aluminium cans, trays and foil
- Steel cans, aerosols and spray cans
- Milk and juice cartons, tetrapaks
- Cardboard boxes and paper
- Plastic cutlery
- Newspapers and magazines

Your fortnightly **Landfill** service



These items go in your red Landfill bin:

- Foam and polystyrene
- Broken glass and mirrors
- Crockery
- Nappies, continence and sanitary products
- Plastic bags and soft plastics
- Old clothing and shoes
