History

William Richardson, the son of early Cowes settler, Joseph Richardson, constructed the house in 1887. William was a boatman and jetty builder and his eldest son, Charlie, was a well known skipper on the Western Port ferries and lived in the cottage until his death in 1984.

Single-storey, double-fronted weatherboard Victorian cottage with corrugated galvanised steel gabled roof and verandah and brick chimneys. Weatherboard outbuildings including intact stables and timber picket fence.
