Description

Red brick cairn/obelisk on plinth. Marble inscription and brass plaque. Later permapine posts and rope surround.

Marble Plaque: A party which included Paul Edmund Strezlecki, James Macarthur, James Riley and Charlie Tara reached here on 12th May 1840. 9th April 1927.

Brass Plaque: Further exhaustive research has revealed that an exploration party of James Macarthur, Edmund de Strzelecki, James Riley, Charley Tarra, John Kent, James Nolan having journeyed from NSW via Omeo South then West through Gippsland. Arrived here 12th May 1840.
