



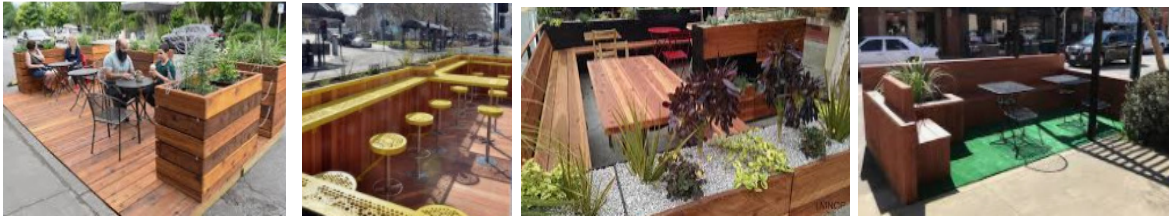
Footpath Trading – Fees Waived until June 2021
