We would again like to thank all who provided feedback and returned their completed questionnaires to Council. These questionnaires were sent to property owners. A brief summary of the results are as follows:

- Forty six percent (46%) of property owners responded to the questionnaire
- Sixty seven percent (67%) of responding property owners see that there is a need for road and drainage improvements
- Fifty two percent (53%) of responding property owners would like to see the upgrade occur and would be willing to contribute

Council met on 9 December 2015 and resolved that based on the information received, it is recommended that Council move onto the next phase, being the Project Planning Stage.

The first step of the Project Planning Stage is to develop concept plans. To develop these concept plans, comprehensive drainage and traffic studies will be conducted and community engagement sessions will be held. Once these concept plans have been developed, they will be presented to the community to gather an understanding of how the Pioneer Bay estate should look.

There will be several concept plan designs presented to the community which may include a road and drainage upgrade design, a roads only upgrade design, a drainage only upgrade design, footpath options, landscaping options and the possibility of traffic calming devices.

The property owners will be notified by letter of the date of the next community engagement session, which we anticipate will take place in April 2016. We will also continue to update our website with progress information and upcoming engagement sessions.
